Specifically, caspase inhibition significantly enhanced, while RPKS inhibition reduced the early expression of type I interferons and cytokine/chemokines in H/N9-infected monocytes. Moreover, culture supernatants from IDN-treated H/N9-infected monocyte promoted the expression of co-stimulatory molecule CD80, CD83 and CD86 on freshly isolated monocytes and monocyte-derived dendritic cells (MDCs) and enhanced the capacity of MDCs to induce CD3+ T-cell proliferation in vitro. In contrast, these immune stimulatory effects were abrogated by using culture supernatants from H7N9-infected monocyte with RIPK3 inhibition. In conclusion, our findings indicated that H/N9 infection activated both appotosis and necroptosis in monocytes. An intact RIPKS activity is required for upregulation of innate immune responses, while caspase activation suppresses the immune response.

The reserve was established in 1962 with an area of 20,000 ha. (Bearer et al., 2008) In 1975, the reserve expanded to its current size of 200,000 ha.
