

HKUL keeps a record of all downloads and will identify cases of excessive downloading.






Step 3: Download additional Filters


Filters are needed for importing references from databases to an Endnote library. Each filter maps the information of a specific database to the corresponding fields in the library. Most of the filters have been installed in Step 2. But, there are some customized filters for HKU users. Download these filters as follows.



In the unzipped folder, select all files by pressing Command + A on the keyboard.




- (a) Go to the Applications \ EndNote 20 \ Filters Folder.
