As the human population continues to increase, demands on natural resources grow larger; few places on Earth are unaffected by human a (Bearer, et al., 2008). Even many nature reserves, or "protected areas", are not well protected from human interference. Nature reserves are a traditional approach to biodiversity conservation, but their effectiveness is limited by increasing human pressures. (Figure 1)

The objective to protect wildlife and other species is often in serious conflict with the needs for socioeconomic development by local re (Christiansen, 2008).

Although increase in human population pressure has been recognized as a major threat to environmental protection and biodiversity conservation, the mechanisms underlying complex interactions between population and environment or population and biodiversity are largely unknow (Wildt, 2006).
