2021 JUN 8 (NewsRx) -- By a News Reporter-Staff News Editor at TB & Outbreaks Week -- New research on Coronavirus - COVID-19 is the subject of a report. According to news reporting originating in Hong Kong, People's Republic of China, by NewsRx journalists, research stated, "The ongoing coronavirus pandemic threatens physical and psychological health. We examined whether social dominance orientation (SDO), a preference for inequality among social groups, contributes to mental health during the pandemic."

The news reporters obtained a quote from the research from the University of Hong Kong, "In particular, we predicted that people high in SDO would experience higher levels of depression than others low in SDO. Our results (N = 2008) showed that SDO was positively associated with depression. In addition, participants' perceived lifestyle changes moderated the association between SDO and depression."

According to the news reporters, the research concluded: "We also discuss the theoretical and practical implications of the current work."

This research has been peer-reviewed.




Q: Can I search for everything that are available in the databases subscribed by the library?

A: FIND@HKUL is a tool for discovering indexed information, it does not guarantee access to all full text articles retrieved.

In fact, full text accessibility depends on a number of contributing factors such as subscription coverage, source of the article, and occasional changes to the subscription platform and configuration on the vendor's side.

In many cases, the external changes are beyond the Libraries' knowledge and control.



Q: Can I have remote access to the ebooks and online articles subscribed by other local university libraries via Find@HKUL?

A: No. Remote access to non-HKUL electronic resources is restricted to the eligible users of the hosting libraries due to licensing agreement. Access to these electronic resources may be available within those libraries. You may apply for a JULAC card to visit and use the resources on-site.
