Peer-reviewed: a process by which a scholarly work (such as a paper or a research proposal) is checked by a group of **experts** in the same field to make sure it meets the necessary standards before it is published or accepted.



- × Not all works are peer-reviewed, some are not reliable
- × Too many results and it takes time to select

Find@HKUL


- ✓ Quick start for all library resources

- Sometimes too many results when your keywords are not specific enough

Go to databases when you need:





OR Boolean operator	Broaden search results - related concepts - synonyms	(blended learning OR flipped learning) AND children
Parentheses ()	enclose the search terms and link them up with OR	Higher education AND (challenges OR risk OR problem)




Change sorting to identify the most high-impacted research using Citations: highest first




No. of articles cited

- Provide references cited for articles published after 1996




