
Understanding Plagiarism






Turnitin Feedback Studio is an academic tool, used by 34 million students and 15,000 institutions worldwide.

2. You are given a set of <u>Class ID</u> and Class Enrollment Key Once a Turnitin assignment is created by instructor, you can submit papers to Turnitin via Moodle.

No need to create a student account separately.

- Click "Create Account"
- Select "Student"
- Complete the form with Class ID and Class Enrollment Key
- Use your HKU email address to register

For students who have submitted any Turnitin assignments via Moodle before, go to Login > Forgot your password? <u>Click</u> here to reset your password.

What if you have several accounts?

- Not recommended as it is not convenient to manage
- Students in active classes count against HKU's student limit. Once the limit is reached, no other students can enroll in classes and submit papers.
- Please request to merge multiple user accounts via the Turnitin Help Desk or the Libraries.

What can I submit?

Requirements for single file upload

· File must be less than 100 MB (read suggestions to meet requirements)

If your file contains images, you may remove the images or save the file as a rich text or plain text file to make the file smaller. If your file is a PDF and exceeds the 100 MB restriction: (1) copy the text in the document, (2) change the upload process to 'copy and paste', and (3) paste the text in the body field.

- All file types are allowed and can receive marks in GradeMark and PeerMark; however, only Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, WordPerfect, PostScript, PDF, HTML, RTF, OpenOffice (ODT), Hangul (HWP), Google Docs, and plain text files with at least 20 words of text will be eligible to receive Similarity Reports

What is a Similarity Report?

- A typical submission made to an assignment in Turnitin generates a Similarity Report.
- The Similarity Report is the result of a comparison between the text of the submission against the search targets selected for the assignment
- Any matching or highly similar text discovered is detailed in the Similarity Report
- The similarity score is a percentage of a paper's content that matches Turnitin's databases; it is not an assessment of whether the paper includes plagiarized material.

Interpreting the Similarity Report

The similarity index does not reflect whether the paper carries plagiarized materials. It is an indication of the word-for-word match with the Turnitin database.

- Blue: No matching text
- Green: One word to 24% matching text
- Yellow: 25-49% matching text
- Orange: 50-74% matching text
- Red: 75-100% matching text

How does the Similarity Report help students?

It can help students improve their writing:

- Check if you have cited sources used in your paper
- You may review whether the intext citations / bibliography are written consistently and correctly
- Are your writing referring to too many sources? Do remember to include your own ideas




Exclude Quotes and Bibliography

Removing the quotations and bibliography will reduce the similarity index temporarily. It must be handled by the instructor.



Why the similarity report cannot be generated?

- Assignment settings:
 - Instructor has set "Generate reports on the due date"
 - If any file type is allowed, Turnitin will not generate a Similarity Report for certain types of files
- The submission is a resubmission
- Turnitin service outage
- and more...

Can I check my own papers in Turnitin?

- Turnitin is for checking students' works
- Please stay tuned for the release of Draft Coach for Microsoft Word on the web, which allows students to check their papers without submitting them via assignment boxes created by instructors



Can I submit multiple files to a Turnitin assignment box?

• The multiple file upload option is not supported. You can only upload a single file at any one time.



How to delete a paper in Turnitin?

- Students cannot remove submissions from their assignments.
- Please contact your instructor for paper deletion and provide a reason and the Paper ID. The instructor could inform HKU Turnitin Administrator for deleting the paper permanently in the database.



My paper got a 100% match, what can I do?

- Have you / someone submitted your paper to another class?
- Please explain the case to your instructor. If he/she is convinced, he/she can exclude the matching source in your Similarity Report for you.

Useful Tips



You are allowed **three resubmission attempts** where the Similarity Report will **generate immediately**. After three attempts, you'll have to **wait 24 hours** before a new Similarity Report can be generated.



Re-submission will **overwrite** the original file submission in the same assignment box.

Useful Tips



Never use another student's account to submit your paper as it will be stored in the Turnitin database permanently.



Students **cannot delete a paper permanently** in the database. Explain this to your instructor who, if convinced, can inform HKU Turnitin Administrator to remove the match from the current report.
